UAW President's Corner

Greetings 869 Family,

There's a lot of positive movement happening within the Stellantis group. As communicated last week, three new products have been announced for production. The first, scheduled for our neighboring facility, will be a mid-size SUV designed to compete in the Yukon/Tahoe market — expected to bring approximately 900 jobs back to the Warren Truck Assembly Plant.

The remaining two vehicles will be produced at the new Belvidere Plant, a project estimated to employ around 3000 ppl. 5000 new members in total. The company also projects a need for nearly 850 new skilled tradespeople to support operations across all facilities.

As you can imagine, these new products will require stamped components — and Warren Stamping is ready for the challenge. Your committee continues to press every week for additional work, wherever it can be attained.

No layoffs are currently planned.

Technology Update:

The company has informed us that the new Spider Die Moving System is scheduled to arrive at Warren Stamping in the fourth quarter. Once fully implemented, this technology is expected to impact 21 members.
